

Job description: Carers Support Officer Linking carers with support and services

## **Specific Duties**

- 1. Obtain and maintain good local knowledge of the community, third sector and statutory services, relevant contracts and referral and referral routes; work closely with officers of external organisations to access information and help to assist carers.
- 2. Receive, manage, and respond to queries and referrals; work closely with colleagues to discuss, prioritise and deal with cases.
- 3. Assess the needs of carers and determine the most appropriate information and support to provide them and the most appropriate course of action to meet the identified needs.
- 4. Refer to external agencies as needed.
- 5. Maintain our monitoring and evaluation systems to record work done and outcomes of work with carers.
- 6. To be responsible for administrative tasks related to the above duties.
- 7. To provide written and oral reports as required by the Chief Officer and Board of Trustees.
- 8. Attend meetings and training courses as required, including staff meetings and supervision sessions.

## **General Duties**

- 1. Be committed to the work of Carers Outreach Service and promote effective team working and collaboration across health, social care and the third sector.
- 2. To work within the organisation's policies and procedures and in accordance with the organisation's values, mission, and strategic plan.
- 3. Undertake any other duties that the Chief Officer may require of you, commensurate with this role.
